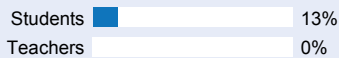

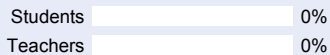

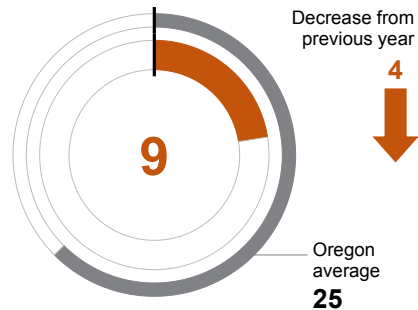

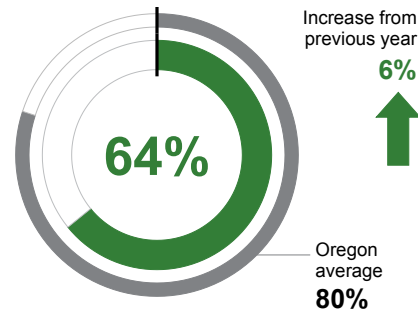
CLASS SIZE

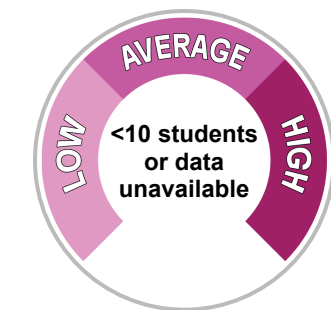
Students who attended more than 90% of their enrolled school days.

INDIVIDUAL STUDENT PROGRESS

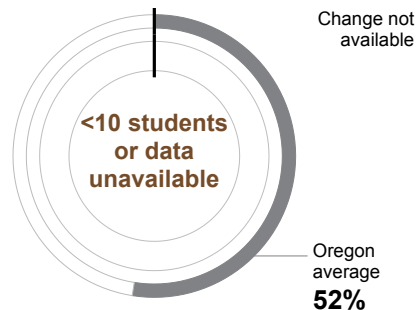
Year-to-year progress in English language arts and mathematics.

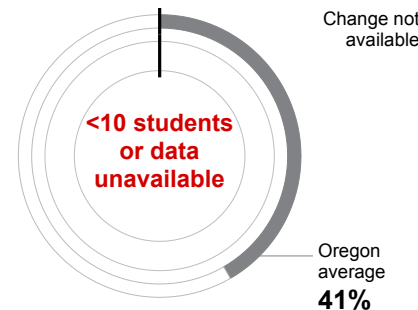
ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS

Students meeting state grade-level expectations.



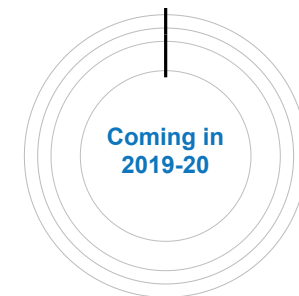
MATHEMATICS

School Goals

Following the guidelines of the Pinehurst Progress Plan and Continuous Improvement Process, the Pinehurst School District works to achieve strategies to vigorously maintain and improve the academic quality and financial stability of this 111-year-old rural school district in the heart of the Cascade-Siskiyou National Monument. Pinehurst School currently offers a vibrant in-house K-5 program. Resident students in grades 6-12 attend schools in Ashland School District.

State Goals

The Oregon Department of Education is partnering with school districts and local communities to ensure a 90% on-time, four year graduation rate by 2025. To progress toward this goal, the state will prioritize efforts to improve attendance, provide a well-rounded education, invest in implementing culturally responsive practices, and promote continuous improvement to close opportunity and achievement gaps for historically and currently underserved students.
