






**GUIDANCE FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2020-21** 


As you may have heard, Governor Brown modified the regulations and expectations about school operations in a COVID-19 environment. Beginning January, 2021, the state metrics for school reopening have moved from mandatory to advisory. While the metrics have not been removed, the ability for local governments, school districts and agencies to work together on school safety and reopening has increased.

What does this mean for Pinehurst? Luckily, Pinehurst School will be able to continue to operate fully on-site as long as there is no community spread of Covid-19 in the district's catchment area. Please consider your role in keeping our community safe by continuing to socially distance, wear a mask and not go anywhere public if you are experiencing symptoms of sickness.

The Oregon Department of Education (ODE), in coordination with the Oregon Health Authority (OHA), continually updates the Ready Schools, Safe Learners guidance for the 2020-21 School Year in accordance with Governor Brown's Executive Order 20-29. This guidance is effective July 1, 2020 and will remain in effect through June 30, 2021 unless replaced by updated guidance.
